## **Program Management in Non-Classified Environments**

The core of any successful project lies with a sound Management and Administrative Team. At MAR, we provide only the most punctual and reliable Program Management staff to our customers, and employ Earned Value Management (EVM) on all projects. We have developed an EVM system, Task Tracker, which follows ANSI/EIA 748 standards. It can be tailored to meet the specific requirements of our large scale programs down to small individual projects.

MAR conducts task planning, including the definition and set-up of task technical and financial performance reports. We plan and oversee monthly, quarterly, and annual project status reviews and reports, and plan and schedule all client and subcontractor discussions. Additional services include developing task technical goals, milestone schedules, work breakdown schedules, and project spend plans; developing operational test, field logistics, and training plan policies and procedures; monitoring task performance against client-established performance metrics; and planning and providing all contract/subcontract administration. It is our aspiration to ensure through these services that every aspect of our customer's program operation is coordinated and carried out promptly, accurately, and within budget.

## **Program Management in Classified Environments**

In support of classified programs, under multiple contracts, MAR provides integrated project planning services across multiple Government organizations within the Intelligence Community. MAR, as a prime contractor, provides overall Program Management and Project Coordination for several ongoing efforts, coordinating the roles and responsibilities of several subcontractors working together as a team to develop and deliver advanced systems. Past projects have covered a broad and diverse variety of work, including analysis dissemination and coordination for bio-threat and DNA-based detection, identification, data collection and dissemination, comparative and forensic analysis, training, logistics, and operations.
